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

Staying secure: small steps with big impacts.

As we embrace the convenience and accessibility of digital banking, amidst rising fraud, we must also pay attention to the safety of our personal information online. Let's talk about some important steps to protect your identity in this always-changing digital world.

Set Strong Passwords: Your first line of defense in digital banking is a robust password. Aim for a combination of uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters. Don't use easily guessed information like birthdays or names. Change your passwords every few months for added security. Our employees will not ask you for your online banking password and you should not give it to anyone.

Enable Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA): This adds an extra layer of security to your accounts. After entering your password, you'll be prompted to verify your identity again – perhaps with a code sent to your phone or email. It's a small step that makes a big difference! Again, do not give this code to anyone. Our employees will not ask you for this information.

Be Cautious with Emails and Texts: If you receive an email or text message asking for your banking information, don't click on any links or give out your details. Scammers often try to pose as banks or credit unions. Remember, C1CU will never ask for sensitive information via email or text.

Regularly Monitor Your Accounts: Keep an eye on your accounts and transactions. If you see something unfamiliar, notify us immediately. You can easily monitor your accounts with our online banking service and mobile app.

Use Secure Wi-Fi: When accessing your financial information, avoid using public Wi-Fi networks. These can be unsecure and expose your data to potential thieves. Instead, use a secure and private network.

Update Your Devices: Keep your smartphones, tablets, and computers updated. These updates often include security enhancements to protect your personal information.

Protect Your Personal Information: Keep personal information like your Social Security number and account details secure. Don't share this information unless it's necessary and you trust the recipient.
